## 28<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

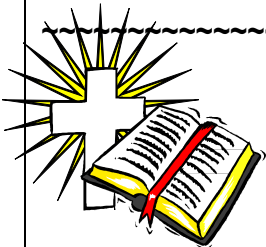
